<b>Week of:</b>	<b>Theme:</b>
<b>June 3- 7</b>	<b>Fun with Water:</b> There is no better way to kick off summer than with a fun filled week of learning about water. Children will be participating in sensory water play, a balloon toss, and lessons in art, math and science. To end the week, children will create sailboats to be used in a sailboat race on Friday!
<b>June 10-14</b>	<b>Grow Fit Kids:</b> We're going to have an obstacle course week! The children will crawl through tunnels, jump through hoops, play tug-a-war, bounce in a bounce house, and more. They will make a fruit salad for snack time and their very own fruit ice pops.
<b>June 17-21</b>	<b>World Travelers:</b> Each day the class will take their passport and travel the globe! Classrooms will be decorated to resemble different countries. The children will be exploring different aspects of each country including food, art, music, and culture.
<b>June 24-28</b>	<b>Building a Rocketship:</b> Put on your space suit and grab your rocketship as we explore space through science and art. Every group will be building their very own rocketship to launch at the end of the week. We will also be enjoying Kona Ice as a special treat.
<b>July 1-5</b>	<b>No summer camp this week! Happy 4th of July!</b>
<b>July 8-12</b>	<b>Barnyard Fun:</b> The children will learn about life on the farm. They will sing songs, play games, read stories and make crafts. This camp will include live encounters with bunnies, chickens, ducks, a baby goat, a pony, and more! The children will also have the opportunity to take photos with their favorite animals!
<b>July 15-19</b>	<b>Robots and Loose Parts:</b> The children will be designing and building their very own robots! On Friday, children will be watching the movie <i>Robots</i> and can wear their pajamas while enjoying pizza, popcorn and glow sticks.
