Principles and Policy Items

Strategic Vision for Academics

- Dr. Errthum reviewed the 11 Components that CPS is currently rated on. Of course all components are important but based on historical performance data, CPS will be focusing on math, social studies and science this year. Benchmark assessments were conducted at the end of August to start collecting valuable data to drive instruction.
- IXL Math is being implemented for students in Kindergarten through Geometry (up to 10th grade). Students are required to complete 20 minutes of practice each week at home.
- This year, there is a designated science teacher for 4th and 5th grade students. The curriculum is aligned with the standards and takes a mastery-based approach to learning. 49% of current 5th grade students have already tested Proficient on the August benchmark exam which is remarkable.
- K-3 students engage in a content-rich science curriculum.

Monitoring and Reporting Items

- Mrs. McIntyre reviewed the variance report for July and August.
- Cash-on-hand projections and capitalization bond requirements remain on pace for the new school year.
- Student enrollment data was reviewed and there are currently 17 more students enrolled for the 2020-21 school year than was originally projected in February.
- The public meeting was adjourned at 10:09 a.m.
