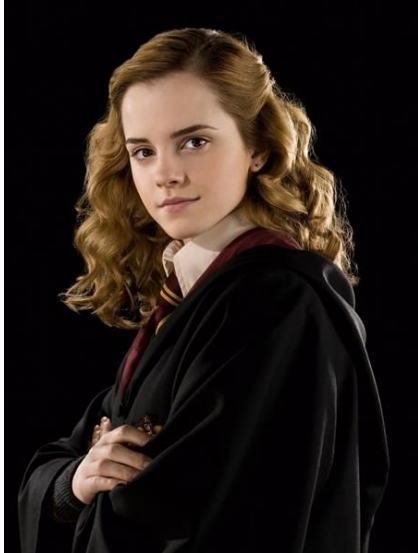

Boosterthon (March)

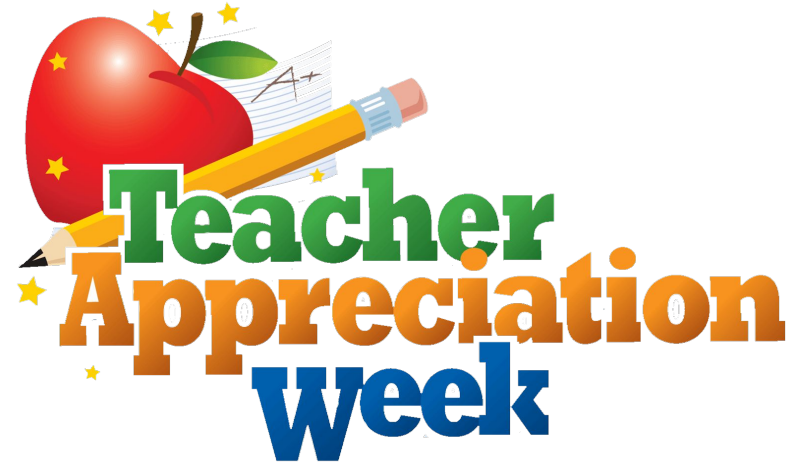

Buyout Programs

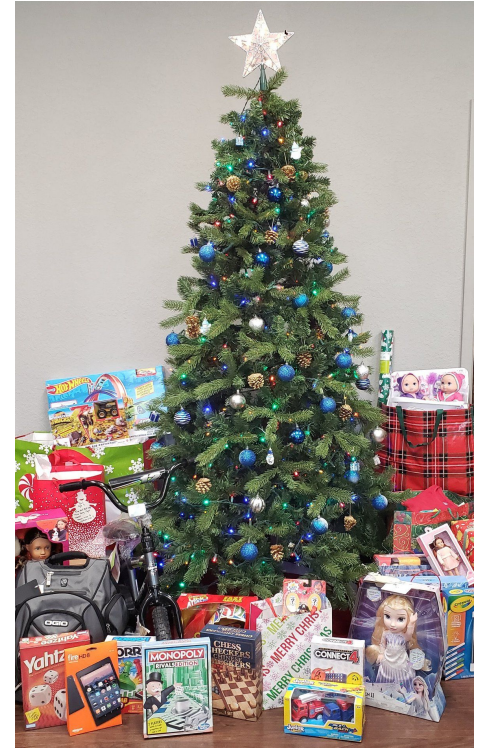
- Spirit Shirt Distribution
