Organization System

One of the main obstacles students face in academic success is a lack of organization. In our many years as teachers, we have found a correlation between academic success and a student's organization system, primarily because of students having a location for their notes, handouts, and graded work for each class. Students must also write down details for their homework in their planner each day.

For our middle school scholars, we will be using a consistent organization system in our classes so that we can work with you as their parents to help them stay organized. Some classes will require binders because of the handouts, and other classes will require a colored folder.

Students will take notes in their five-subject notebook for any classes that require a folder. Each section of the spiral notebook will be for a different class. They will use loose leaf notebook paper for classes with binders to take notes that go in their binder or to complete assignments that need to be turned in.
