### **Teacher Donations**

*Students will bring these supplies with them during the Meet the Teacher event in August.*

- One 8-pack of colored chisel tip Expo markers (low odor)
- One 12-pack of Crayola colored pencils
- Four pads of 3" x 3" Post-It notes
- Four packs of 3" x 5" index cards (blank)
- Four boxes of tissues
- Two canisters of disinfecting wipes (Clorox or Lysol brand preferred)
- Two bottles of hand sanitizer (Germ-X brand preferred)
- One ream of white copy paper

### **Personal Student Supplies for All Classes**

### **Binders vs. Folders**

One of the main obstacles students face in academic success is a lack of organization. In our many years as teachers, we have found the following two options work well to ensure that students have a location for their notes, handouts, and graded work for each class. Please discuss ideas and options to help your child decide what will work best and be most realistic to maintain.

#### **Binder System**

- 1" Binder per class or per 2 classes\*
- 5-pack tab dividers for each binder
- Five Star brand five-subject perforated spiral notebooks (college ruled) - **one per quarter**
- Loose leaf notebook paper (college ruled) (students will have 7 classes total) - **one per quarter**

\*Students will have 7 classes total.

#### **Folder System**

- Blue** 3-Prong Folder with Pockets (Math)
- Yellow** 3-prong folder with pockets (English)
- Green** 3-prong folder with pockets (Science)
- Red** 3-prong folder with pockets (History)
- Purple** 3-prong folder with pockets (Latin, Spanish)
- White** 3-prong folder with pockets (Logic, Rhetoric, Philosophy, Humanities)
- Orange** 3-prong folder with pockets (HOPE)
- Five Star five-subject perforated spiral notebooks (college ruled) = one per quarter
- Packs of loose leaf notebook paper (college ruled) = one per quarter
