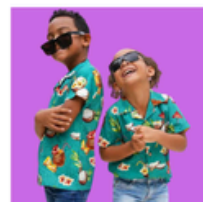

SPIRIT WEEK GUIDELINES

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED



No wigs or hair color allowed.



No full-face masks, masquerade masks, or face paint are allowed.
Exception: Scholars may wear a small amount of face paint on Thursday (Classical Prep Spirit Day).



No elaborate or difficult-to-sit-in clothing is allowed. Scholars must be able to use the restroom without assistance.



No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes. Bottoms can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.



No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.



No pajamas or costumes.



No hats, hooded clothing, or bandanas.
