Wednesday, May 21st & Thursday, May 22nd Dress Code: Remember your child(ren) can wear a spirit shirt (current or past year) with uniform bottoms as they will be helping to pack up and clean classrooms for summer.

Friday is the Last Day of School & a Half Day! Dress Code and Items to Bring: Please keep in mind the following when sending your child(ren) to school and half day (dismissal at 12:00 p.m.)

- **What does my child(ren) need to bring with him/her?**
 - Small drawstring backpack
 - Black Sharpie marker to sign t-shirts
 - Pen for signing yearbooks
 - Water bottle
 - Beach towel to sit on outside
 - Hat and/or sunglasses for outdoor activities
 - Sunscreen
- **What is the dress code for the day? (Comfortable athletic-wear clothing is strongly encouraged)**
 - Shorts (athletic shorts are allowed) should fall 2 inches above the knee (uniform length)
 - No spandex or skin-tight clothing
 - No muscle shirts, tank tops, or strapless tops
 - Athletic shoes are recommended (no slippers, Crocs or similar footwear)
 - No leggings, yoga pants, tights, or similar clothing
 - T-shirts must be long enough to clearly overlap the beltline (with no offensive wording or images on it)

DRESS-DOWN DAY GUIDELINES

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED



No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes. Bottoms can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.



No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.



No pajamas or costumes.



No hats, hooded clothing, or bandanas.



No crops tops or shirts that expose the belly button/skin when arms are raised.



No open toed shoes. No slippers or similar footwear such as Crocs or shoes without backs.
