Summer Work Update for Math for Data and Financial Literacy (MDFL) and Precalculus

This message is to clarify the summer work expectations for scholars enrolled in Math for Data and Financial Literacy (MDFL) or Precalculus for the 2025–26 school year. We've made a small update to the summer skills practice and the new links are included below. Additionally, please visit the school website to view the revised instructions and updated skills packets.

IXL Summer Math Instructions For Scholars:

To help you prepare for a strong start to the 2025–26 school year, we're asking all

scholars who will be enrolled in Math for Data and Financial Literacy (MDFL) or Precalculus to complete a summer math review using IXL.

Step 1: Update Your Diagnostic

Before beginning the skills packet, please log in to IXL and complete your Diagnostic Update. This will give us the most accurate picture of where you are and help you target the skills that need reinforcement.

- Log in to your IXL account.
- Click on the “Diagnostic” tab.
- Work through the diagnostic questions until it says your diagnostic is up to date, and continue to update weekly.

Step 2: Work Through the Summer Skills Packet (SmartScore Goal: 80-100 for each skill)

Step 3: Focus on Personalized Skill Recommendations (SmartScore Goal: 80-100 for each skill)

In addition to the skills in the packet, you should also spend time working on any skill areas identified by your diagnostic. These are tailored just for you and are meant to strengthen any gaps before the school year begins.

- Check your “Recommendations” tab in IXL to find skills flagged for practice.
- Aim to complete 3–5 of these personalized skills each week.

Make sure to pace yourself, do your best, and take pride in your progress. We’re excited to see the growth you’ll bring into the new school year!

Instructions For New Scholars To Access Email, Google Classroom & IXL

To support our scholars as they embark on their math summer work, we have created Google Classrooms with videos and practice IXL codes. In order to access these resources, your scholar needs to be signed in to his or her Classical Prep email address. Volunteer applications must be approved by the district before volunteering. Please keep in mind that it can take up to 30 days for the background check to be processed.
