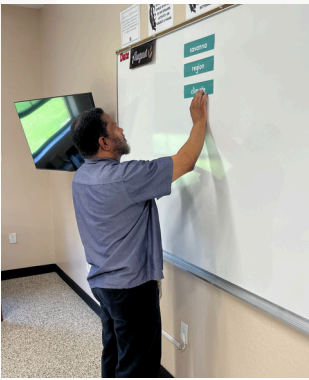

First Day of School Reminders!

MONDAY,

We are so excited to see all of our scholars on campus this Monday, August 11th! We wanted to share a few reminders to make sure you and your child(ren) are ready for the first day of school. We also wanted to provide any information you may have missed if you were not able to attend Meet and Greet.

School Start & End Times: School starts promptly at 7:30 AM for 6th through 12th grade scholars and ends at 2:31 PM.

- Morning carline begins at 7:00 AM.
- Afternoon carline lineup begins at 2:15 PM. Carline starts at 2:31 PM.

School Supplies:

- If you did not drop off your child(ren)'s school supplies at Meet and Greet, please bring them on the first day of school.

Schedules:

- We will post the first-period teacher for all scholars on the bulletin boards in the Atrium for them to reference. Families can also log on to MyStudent to see their child(ren)'s schedule. Please ensure you are checking My Student for any updates on schedules before Monday.

Dress Uniform Monday:

- The first day of school is Dress Uniform Monday for all K-12 scholars. Scholars are required to wear their Oxford Dress Shirt, tie, and approved uniform bottoms.

Emergency Cards & Parental Bill of Rights:

- The Emergency Cards and Parental Bill of Rights for the 2025-26 school year are due Monday, August 11th. These must be completed, even if your contact information has not changed. These are available in the myStudent Parent Portal.

Summer Assignments:

- All summer assignments are due on the first day of school, Monday, August 11th.

After-Care Programs:

Do you want to help speed up carline? Please review the procedures below and complete setting up your PikMyKid account (used only for afternoon dismissal).

Morning Carline

- **Start Times:**
 - **7:00 AM** – Logic & Rhetoric Carline (Grades 6–12)
 - **7:20 AM** – Grammar Carline (Grades K–5)
- Wait for a staff member to move the cones before pulling around.
- Scholars must exit from the passenger side only.
- Parents/guardians must stay in their vehicle at all times.
- Keep backpacks inside the car (not in the trunk) to maintain flow and safety.
- Pull forward as directed to help keep the line moving efficiently.

Afternoon Carline

- **Cars can begin lining up at 2:00 PM for afternoon carline. No cars will be permitted to enter campus beyond our gate until after this time.**

- **Start Times:**
 - 2:31 PM – Logic/Rhetoric (Grades 6–12)
 - 2:50 PM – Grammar (Grades K–5)

- **New 2025-26 car tag must hang from your rearview mirror (received at Meet and Greet):**
 - Blue side for Logic/Rhetoric (Grades 6–12)
 - Yellow side for Grammar (Grades K–5)
 - If you did not attend Meet and Greet, your car tag will be sent home in your youngest child’s backpack on Monday.

- **PikMyKid App Instructions:**
 - All families must have their PikMyKid account registered and set up to use on the first day of school.

 - How to announce you are on campus to pick up your child(ren):
 - Open the app at the Announce Station (map on page X)
 - Ensure location services are ON.
 - Tap “Pickup,” select your child(ren), then press ANNOUNCE.
 - All families must stop at the Check-In Station

- **Traffic Flow & Safety Reminders**
 - The campus is one-way traffic only. All cars must enter from Shady Hills Road.
 - Lane Breakdown on Carline Map (included on page 6):
 - Blue (right) – Logic/Rhetoric (Grades 6–12)
 - Green (left) – Grammar (Grades K–5)
 - There are two Green lanes designated for Grammar carline.
 - Morning Carline: Use the left Green lane only. The right lane is closed in the morning.
 - Afternoon Carline: Fill the left Green lane first, then begin using the right lane. When carline begins, merge into a single lane. This area is not monitored by staff, so please be patient and take turns merging safely.
 - Orange (middle) – Emergency vehicles, medical passes & staff only
 - Purple – Early Academy (do not use unless directed)

- **Important Notes:**

- Families with both K-5 & 6-12 start in the Logic/Rhetoric lane and merge.
 - Do not use the Gym for pickup/drop-off.
 - Please follow the signage and directions of the Classical Prep staff members while moving through carline.
 - Two exit lanes form as you leave campus. Please note that a third lane for the apartment complex is not to be used by our families (see carline map for details). Please merge carefully.
 - Please allow extra time to drop off and pickup your child(ren) due to the construction on Shady Hills Road. Classical Prep staff members cannot direct traffic on Shady Hills Road, but we will have assistance from the Pasco County Sheriff's Office when available for the first few days of school.

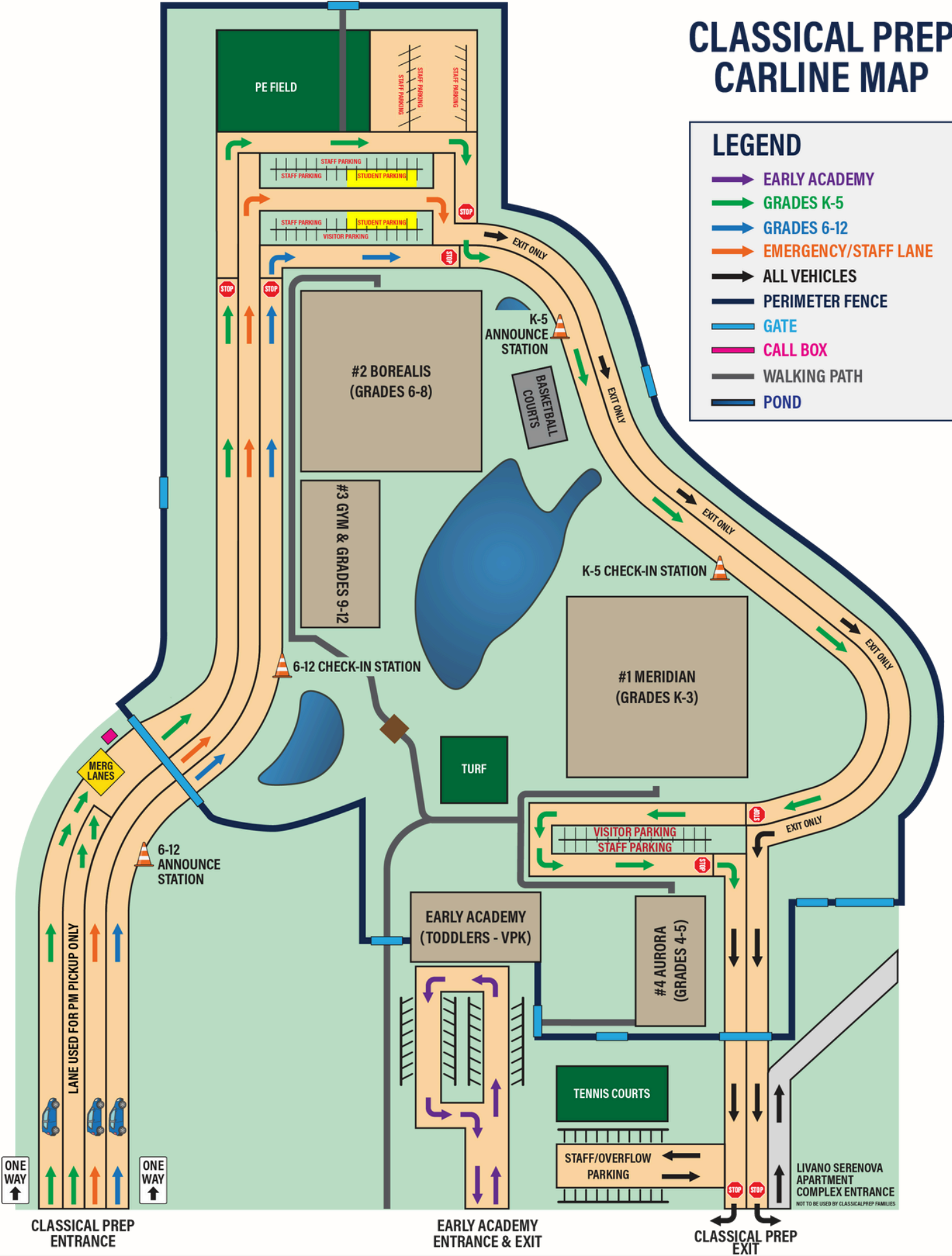
Once your child(ren)'s schedule(s) are available, you will be able to view them after these steps have been completed. We estimate that all schedules will be finalized by August 4th.

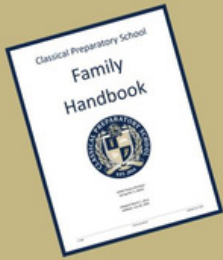

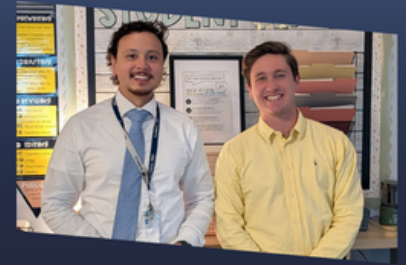
