IMPORTANT CHANGES TO ABSENCE REPORTING

Beginning **September 10, 2025**, Classical Prep will implement a new way to report scholar absences in alignment with Pasco County School District procedures.

Absences **must** now be reported through the **myStudent Parent Portal**. Step-by-step directions for accessing and completing the form on both computer and mobile devices are included below. We have also added the directions to our website, along with a direct link to the portal.

Please remember: Absences **must be reported within three (3) days** to be considered excused.

Pre-Arranged Absences: Families will still complete the Pre-Arranged Absence Request Forms through the Classical Prep website. These forms can be found under the Parents Tab and must be completed at least seven (7) days before the absence.

Pasco County Schools has also released the **Attend and Achieve Manual**, which outlines Universal Attendance Procedures and emphasizes the importance of consistent school attendance. Our goal is to reduce absenteeism and support higher student achievement. Throughout the year, we will be sharing helpful attendance facts and tips on our website. myStudent Documentation

Absence Reporting Form for Parents

A new Absence Reporting Form is to be used to report your child’s absence. The form is located in the myStudent Parent Portal.

Follow the directions below to access the form from your computer or phone.

From a Web Browser

- Log in to your **myStudent Parent Portal**.
- Go to **Forms** from your menu on the left or top.
- Select **Absence Reporting**

From the myStudent App

- Tap **Open Focus** in the District Announcement message or Absence Reporting from your links page to log in through your browser.
- **Android:** Tap the three dots in the top-right, then select **Open in Chrome**.
- **iOS:** Tap the share icon at the bottom, then select **Open in Chrome** or **Safari**.
- Once in your browser, follow the web browser steps above.

Completing the Absence Report

1. Choose your child from the dropdown — this auto-fills their school, your parent account, and your email.
2. Enter a valid phone number if one is not listed
3. Select the start date of the absence, and end date if it spans multiple days.
4. Pick the appropriate reason for the absence. If “Other,” explain in the text box.
5. (Optional) Add details in the Brief Description field.
6. Check the acknowledgment box.
7. Upload any supporting documents if needed.
8. Click Submit Request after reviewing for accuracy.

- Incomplete IXL practice
- General questions that are easily answered via the gradebook, in myStudent, or teacher communications

Upper school teachers and the Academic Leadership Team have identified scholars whose parents are required to schedule a conference. Those families will receive an email invitation with a link to RSVP by Monday, September 15th.

Scholars who experience ongoing challenges with study habits, and/or behavior, will be contacted at the end of Quarter 1 for a meeting with the scholar, parents, and either the Academic Advisor (6th-10th grade), or the College Counselor (11th-12th grade) in order to develop a plan for improvement.

CONGRATULATIONS COLLEGE BOARD ACADEMIC HONORS RECIPIENTS

We're celebrating six Classical Prep scholars who join over 280,000 students from across the country who earned academic honors from the College Board National Recognition Program!

In 2025, the program offered three awards to students of all backgrounds and across schools nationwide: First-Generation Recognition Award, Rural and Small-Town Recognition Award, and, for the first time, the School Recognition Award, to honor top-performing students in every high school, including lesser-known schools.

Students verify their eligibility during their sophomore or junior year by meeting the following criteria:

- Take the PSAT/NMSQT (10th, 11th), PSAT 10 (10th), and/or AP Exams (by the end of 10th grade).
- Earn a cumulative GPA of B+ or higher (at least 3.3 or 87%-89%) by the time of submission.
- Be one of the top 10% of test takers in their high school, among first-generation college students in their state, and/or among rural and small-town students in their state, OR earn a 3+ on 2 or more distinct AP Exams in the 8th, 9th, and/or 10th grade.

“We’re incredibly proud of our students and to see them recognized for their dedication and excellence,” said Mrs. Clayton, Upper School College Counselor. “This honor reinforces their exceptional achievements in high school and will support them in their pursuit of a big future.”


