 - Parents are to pick up on the designated Fridays between 8:00 AM - 1:00 PM.
 - All orders will be listed under the name on the card used for payment.

On Thursday, September 11th, Classical Prep scholars will spend time learning about the events that happened on September 11th, 2001. The commemorations will highlight the courage of first responders, the solidarity of communities, and the strength of a nation coming together in the face of unimaginable loss. By reflecting on these acts of heroism and compassion, we celebrate the enduring values of hope, resilience, and the unwavering commitment to building a better world. Scholars who are participating are expected to adhere to the [Rules of Appearance and Dress](#) that are outlined on pages 34-35 of the Student Code of Conduct.

Rules for Dress Down Day:

This dress down day is FREE for all scholars. The PRIMARY colors that the scholar should wear are red, white and blue. We want to maintain a positive and productive learning environment for all scholars. Please keep in mind:

- No wigs, hair color, or face paint allowed.
- No full-face or masquerade masks are allowed.
- No elaborate or difficult-to-sit-in clothing is allowed.
- Scholars must be able to use the restroom without assistance.
- No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes.
- Shorts/bottoms can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.
- No pajamas or costumes.

Rules for Dress Down Day Continued:

- No open-toed shoes.
- No slippers or similar footwear such as Crocs or shoes without backs.
- No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.
- No hats or bandanas.
- No hoodies or hooded clothing.
- No crop tops or shirts that expose belly button/skin when arms are raised

Violations will result in disciplinary consequences, and scholars will sit in the front office until a change of clothes are delivered to them.

DRESS-DOWN DAY GUIDELINES

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED



No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes. Bottoms can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.



No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.



No pajamas or costumes.



No hats, hooded clothing, or bandanas.



No crop tops or shirts that expose the belly button/skin when arms are raised.



No open toed shoes. No slippers or similar footwear such as Crocs or shoes without backs.

All Pasco County School volunteers are required to complete the Raptor Volunteer Application yearly, starting on July 1st. Volunteers must also complete a Level 2 background screening every five (5) years.

Volunteer applications must be approved by the district before volunteering. Please keep in mind that it can take up to 30 days for the background check to be processed.
