## **SAFETY CONCERNS IN CARLINE**

Recently, we have had several instances that require attention regarding the drop-off and pick-up of scholars. To ensure everyone's safety, please remember:


- The emergency lane (orange lane on map) **MUST** remain open at all times. This lane is for emergency vehicles, medical passes, and staff only.
- The use of cellphones while driving is prohibited, except to “announce” in PikMyKid. There have been several close calls with someone almost being hit due to distracted driving on phones.
- The speed limit on campus is 10 miles per hour.
- To expedite the pick-up process, car tags must be hanging until your child has been picked up. Please refrain from putting them on your dashboard, as it is difficult for staff to see them.

**Traffic Flow & Updated Traffic Map:** The campus is one-way traffic only. All cars must enter from Shady Hills Road. An updated map has been provided, and is also available on the [Classical Prep website](#).

## Lane Breakdown:

- **Green** (lane 1) - Grammar (K-5) only
- **Orange** (lane 2) - Emergency vehicles, medical passes & staff only. The lane must be kept clear at all times.
- **Blue** (lanes 3 & 4) - Logic/Rhetoric (Grades 6–12) only. Fill the far right blue lane first (lane 4), then begin using lane 3. When traffic begins to move, merge into a single lane. This area is not monitored by staff, so please be patient and take turns merging safely.
- **Purple** – Early Academy (do not use unless directed)

## **Payment for Spirit Week:**

- Scholars who purchased the Spirit Bundle must wear their blue silicone wristbands each day of Spirit Week to participate. If a scholar forgets their wristband or loses it, they can purchase a replacement band for \$2.00 (cash only) upon arrival.

### **Pay at the Door Scholars:**

- Daily wristbands can be purchased each morning during spirit week for \$3.00 (cash only) upon arrival. Scholars will receive a paper wristband that must be displayed to participate (there will be a different color wristband for each day).

Are you planning to shop for your Homecoming outfit this weekend? Be sure to check out the dress code below, so you will know exactly what to wear for the big night!

### **Semi-Formal Dress Code:**

#### **Dress Code for Young Men:**

- Dress slacks, a button-down dress shirt, and dress shoes are required.
- All pants must be securely worn around the waist.

#### **Dress Code for Young Women:**

- Semi-formal attire or pantsuits.
- Dresses are to be no more than 3 inches above the knee (front and back) or 3 inches below the fingertips. This also applies to slits in dresses. The dress must also be at the appropriate length, even if leggings are worn underneath the dress.
- Dress may not be extremely low-cut in the front or back. The front of the dress must not fall below the bra line; the back of the dress must not fall below the waist. Sides must be covered. No dresses are permitted that are open or sheer on the front or sides of the dress unless the openness is covered by solid material.
- Dresses may not be extremely tight/form-fitting. Be aware of the material that gathers and rises when walking.
- If the dress/skirt has sheer material over the lining of the dress, then the lining of the dress must be no more than 3 inches above the knee (front and back). The sheer material is not what will be measured.

# DRESS DOWN DAY GUIDELINES

## ITEMS THAT ARE NOT ALLOWED



No wigs or hair color allowed.



No full-face masks, masquerade masks, or face paint are allowed.  
**Exception:** Scholars may wear a small amount of face paint on Friday (Classical Prep Spirit Day).



No elaborate or difficult-to-sit-in clothing is allowed. Scholars must be able to use the restroom without assistance. Costumes are not permitted.



No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes. Bottoms can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.



No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.



No pajamas or costumes.



No hats, hooded clothing, or bandanas.



No crop tops or shirts that expose the belly button/skin when arms are raised.



No open toed shoes. No slippers or similar footwear such as Crocs or shoes without backs.
