Cold Weather Uniform Policy

Even though we are still experiencing warm temperatures, we wanted to share our Cold Weather Uniform Policy as the season begins to change and temperatures start to lower. Please take a moment to review the policy and to ensure your child(ren) is dressed appropriately for cooler mornings ahead.

Scholars will be allowed to wear certain articles of clothing when the low temperature for the day drops **below 50 degrees**. These items include:

- Solid black, brown, navy, or gray jackets, with or without a hood
- Zippered sweaters, with or without a hood (sweaters need to zip fully, no quarter zip sweaters)
- Gloves and/or mittens in any color
- Beanie hats in any color

Please note that the outerwear listed above should be removed when scholars are in the classroom to maintain a distraction-free and comfortable learning environment.

Please label all articles of clothing with your child(ren)'s name, as we know Florida weather can go from winter to summer in just a few short hours.

6th-12th Grade: Florida Civics Literacy Exam (FCLE)

All students who are enrolled in a high school credited US Government Honors or AP US Government & Politics course this semester will take the Florida Civics Literacy Exam (FCLE) on November 7th.

The Florida Civic Literacy Exam (FCLE) is a computer-based assessment that measures students' civic literacy knowledge. In 2021, legislation was passed that requires all students enrolled in a U.S. Government course in high school to take the assessment (see s. 1003.4282(3)(d), F.S.). However, it is not an end-of-course exam and will not impact their course grade. In the state of Florida, it is required that all students seeking to earn a bachelor's degree from a public college or university must take a civics course and pass the FCLE in order to complete the degree. Students who pass the FCLE while in high school will not be required to take the course or to take the exam again while in their college or university degree program.

The FCLE is one 160-minute session with a break at 80 minutes consisting of 80 multiple choice questions. Students may be dismissed at the break if they are finished. Students may have up to half a typical school day to continue working if they are not finished after 160 minutes.

Important: Scholars **cannot participate** in the health screening **unless the Parent/Guardian Consent Form (Student Bill of Rights) is completed**. Please ensure this form is submitted as soon as possible so your child does not miss out.

Steps to complete the form in MyStudent:

- Log in to the MyStudent App.
- Click the Menu button (three lines in the top corner).
- Select Forms.
- Choose Parent/Guardian Consent Form (one form per student).
- Click Save on each form.


Calling all performers!
