RE-ENROLLMENT FOR 2026-27

For Current Kindergarten - 11th Grade Scholars

STARTS MONDAY!

Monday, January 26 - Friday, January 30

Re-enrollment starts Monday! Parents of currently enrolled scholars must complete their enrollment forms during the re-enrollment period to have their child(ren) attend Classical Preparatory School for the 2026-27 school year. The re-enrollment period will take place from 8:00 a.m. on Monday, January 26, through 4:00 p.m. on Friday, January 30. School fees will also be collected at that time. One form must be completed for each child.

If the re-enrollment process is not completed during the given time period, your child's seat will not be reserved for the 2026-27 school year. Any scholar who does not have a seat reserved during the re-enrollment period will need to go through the lottery process to gain admission to Classical Preparatory School for the 2026-27 school year if they wish to attend.

***Siblings of currently enrolled scholars who do not attend Classical Prep do not apply for admission through re-enrollment. They must complete the lottery application process by March 9, 2026, via [Lotterease](#), and they will receive an enrolled sibling preference.

You will be sent an invitation by email and text that will take you to Enrollease to complete the form. Alternatively, you can log into your account in Enrollease [HERE](#), and the form will be available for you to complete.


Dress Code Violations:

- No jeans, pants, or shorts with rips, frayed hems (or edges), or holes.
- Shorts can be no shorter than three (3) inches above the knee.
- No pajamas or costumes.
- No slippers or similar footwear such as crocs, or shoes without backs.
- No open-toed shoes.
- No leggings, yoga pants, spandex, tights, or similar clothing.
- No hats or bandanas.
- No hoodies or hooded clothing.
- No crop tops or shirts that expose the belly button/skin when arms are raised.

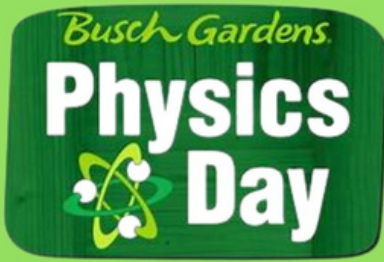
Save the date for our Annual Classical Prep Art Show featuring artwork from every scholar K-5, as well as work from our art scholars in grades 6-12.

9TH-12TH GRADE PHYSICS DAY FIELD TRIP AT BUSCH GARDENS

Date: Friday, March 6, 2026

We are excited to have the 9th-12th-grade scholars attend Physics Day at Busch Gardens on Friday, March 6, 2026. Scholars will receive one hour of exclusive park-ride time and interactive physics stations throughout the park before the general public is allowed into the theme park. Accelerometers are even mounted on select rides for scholars to use. Scholars will experience world-class roller coasters and make some of their physics calculations.

SAT SCHOOL TESTING DAY MARCH 4, 2026



We are pleased to announce that 9 – 12 grade scholars will have the opportunity to take the SAT on March 4, 2026, during the regular school day. Most scholars take the SAT in the 11th and 12th grades, but scholars may take the SAT in 9th – 10th grades as well, helping to familiarize themselves with the way the exam works, to get an early baseline score, and to begin preparation for future test administrations.

- It is the same exam as the weekend SAT, conveniently administered on a school day

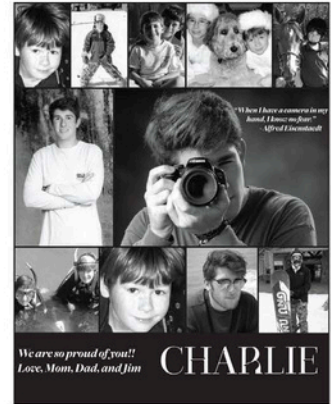
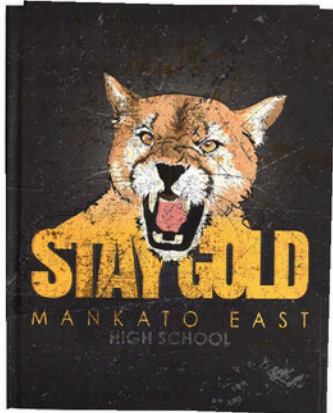

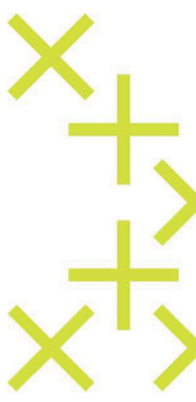
