


# Fire Lane Notice

Recently, you may have noticed the newly painted Fire Lane and speed bumps. These additions have been made to enhance the safety and security of our scholars and everyone on Classical Prep property.

Vehicles are permitted in the Fire Lane only during carline arrival and dismissal. **Per the Pasco County Fire Marshal, parking in the Fire Lane is strictly prohibited at all times**, including during after-school activities and events.

Parents dropping off or picking up their child(ren) outside of carline times—or from after-school activities at both the upper and lower schools—must use the designated visitor parking. **No vehicle may be left unattended in any part of the red Fire Lane.** This lane must remain clear and accessible for emergency vehicles, including ambulances, fire trucks, and police.

Violators will receive an initial warning. Subsequent violations may be referred to the Pasco County Sheriff's Office for enforcement and possible criminal trespass prosecution.

### EKG For Athletes

Please review this [important flyer](#) regarding the required EKG screenings for student athletes. Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, Florida law requires all incoming 9th-grade scholar-athletes to complete an electrocardiogram (EKG) screening before participating in FHSAA- sanctioned sports.

Our district will be partnering with [Who We Play For](#) to offer life-saving electrocardiogram (EKG) heart screenings for all students from 10-22 years of age for \$20 per student. Families may choose to complete the screening at any location listed on the [Pasco County Schools Flyer](#), which contains a link for how to sign up.



- All incoming 9th-grade student-athletes
- Students in grades 10-12 who have never participated in an FHSAA-sanctioned sport
- Any student who transfers to Pasco County Schools and participates in an FHSAA-sanctioned sport
- Returning athletes are not required to obtain an EKG, but it is strongly encouraged.

An EKG performed on or after July 1, 2024 will satisfy this requirement.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

- 1 in 300 youth have a potentially life-threatening, detectable heart condition that could lead to Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
- Sudden Cardiac Arrest is the #1 killer on school campuses and in student-athletes.
- A regular physical misses these conditions 96%-99% of the time.
- A 5-minute, non-invasive EKG catches these conditions 80%-96% of the time.
