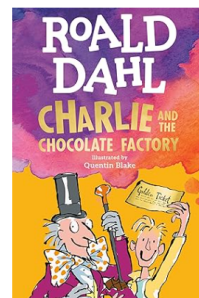

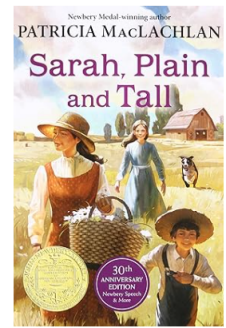


[Sarah Plain and Tall](#) by Patricia MacLachlan
